Mousetrap Race Rules

1. Car kits will be distributed to each chapter director.
2. The mousetrap or car design cannot be physically altered except for the decals
3. Device cannot have any additional potential or kinetic energy at the start other than what can be stored in the mousetrap's own spring.
4. The spring from the mousetrap cannot be altered or heat treated.
5. The spring cannot be wound more than it's normal travel distance or 180 degrees.
6. The vehicle may not receive a push in the forward direction at the start.
7. The vehicle must steer itself.
8. Distance will be measured from the start line to the front of the vehicle when stopped or the point that it left the marked course.
9. The distance will be calculated by deleting the longest and shortest run when adding the remaining 3 runs and dividing by 3 to get an average distance traveled per team.
10. The official make the final decision on all measurements and to appropriateness of any additional items that might be used in the construction of the race car.
11. Each team will be allowed 5 passes only and there must be 5 different team members.
12. To ensure all cars are of the 2018 model, they must be unpainted and only have the chapter logo for decoration.
13. Points will be awarded for chapter participation and for finishing first, second and third.
